Submission of papers

Lond.* no. 1627), which may be obtained from the Executive Secretary at a cost of 7s 6d (Fellows 3s 9d). These notes set out the Society's requirements for the typescript and illustrations and offer many helpful suggestions.

Discussion

The pages of the *Quarterly Journal of Engineering Geology* are open for the discussion of papers that have already appeared therein. Contributions to such discussion should not as a rule exceed 250 words, and will be subject to editing. They should be typewritten, in double spacing on one side of quarto paper, and the author and full title of the paper discussed should appear plainly at the top of the typescript. No correspondence can be entered into about contributions to discussion, neither can proofs of discussions be submitted to the contributors.
